3. Create a safe space where you can talk with any children or teenager and allow them to explain




4. Define the limits of behavior and what is allowed and not to do

6. Encourage and empower the group to support the victim

10. Empower the victim, explain him/her that's not bad to be different






11. Understand which are the bulliers' problems and try to help them
