To define communication strategies, tools, and channels to promote networking activities and the activities developed

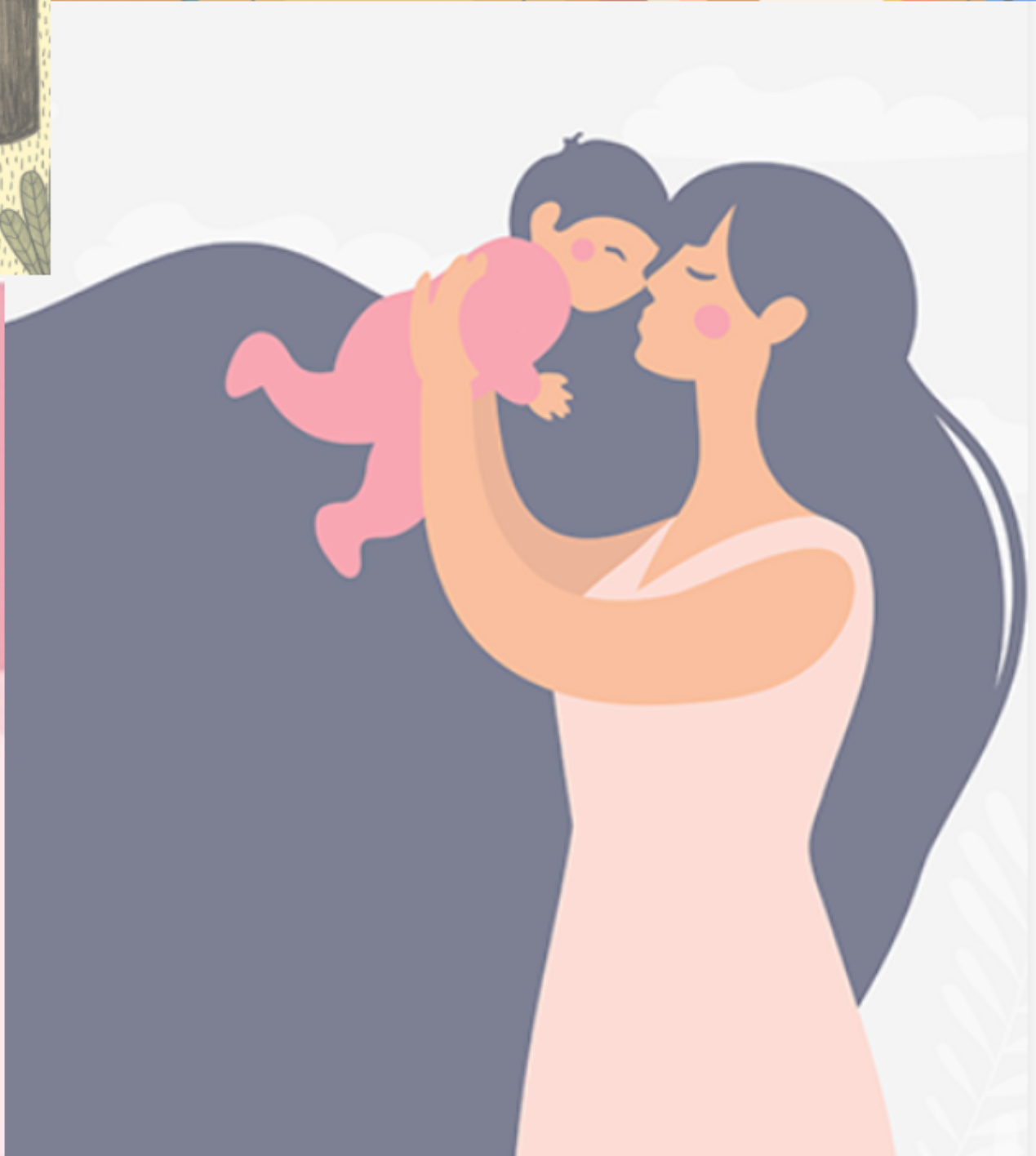
