STORY OF GOOGLE

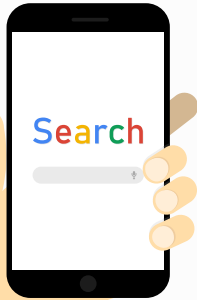

GOOGLE SEARCH

GOOGLE MAPS

- Go to the Google Maps website (www.google.com/maps) or use the mobile app.
- Enter the location or address you want to find in the search bar.
- Explore the map, get directions, find nearby places, and more.





GMAIL (EMAIL)

- Go to the Gmail website (mail.google.com) or use the Gmail app.
- Sign in with your Google account.
- Compose, send, and receive emails. Organize your emails using labels and folders.
